We have been busy over the last few weeks preparing for our assembly by singing and performing, and have enjoyed inviting you as parents into the school to watch.

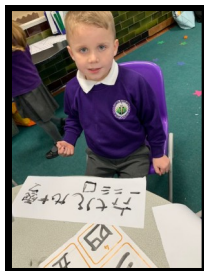

Meithrin / Nursery

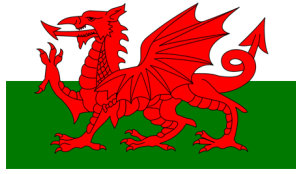

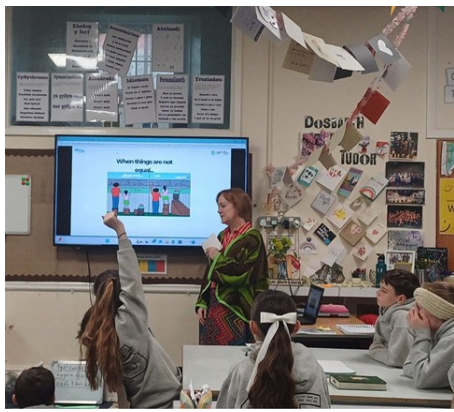
