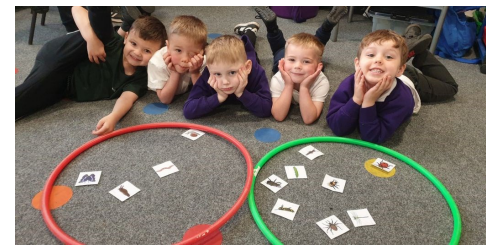

Our time at Techniquest was the perfect way to use our new knowledge and explore scientific aspects of all kinds!

Thank you to all of the Sant Curig Family who have supported the Welsh Language Charter this year.



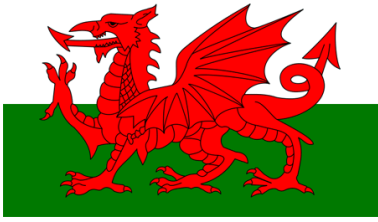
